N= Needs Improvement

U=UnderPerforning

Students in 3 dthrough 12 the grades will receive marks for their overall performance in each course of study using the following letter grade scale.

A= 90 100%

B= 8089%

C= 7079%

D= 6069%

F= **059**%

Grades of 'D' and above are passing marks. Accurse grade of 'F' indicates that the student has failed the course. For 9th 12th grade levels, no course credit will be awarded for a failing course grade.

Kindergatenstudents do not receive course grades. They will receive marks for their proficiency of the learning standards only using the standards scale below

The standards scales will be used to communicate a student's proficiency of the learning standards on assessments and, insome cases, on course work and practice assignments. The standards scores will impact the student's course grade infirst and second grades.

Students in Kindergarten, 1st, and 2nd grades will receive marks for their proficiency toward the grade level standards using the following scale as has been the practice for the past 2 decades in DVUSD

- 4= Applies grade level skills with greater depth are complexity
- 3= Demonstrates grade level proficiency
- 2= Approaches grad

Students in 3 dithrough 12 th grades will receive marks for their proficiency toward the grade level standards using the following scale. The standards marks are informational and do not impact the student's overall course grade.

4= Hehly Proficient

3=Proficient

2= Partially Proficient

1=MrimallyProficient

NE = No Evidence (student work missing)
