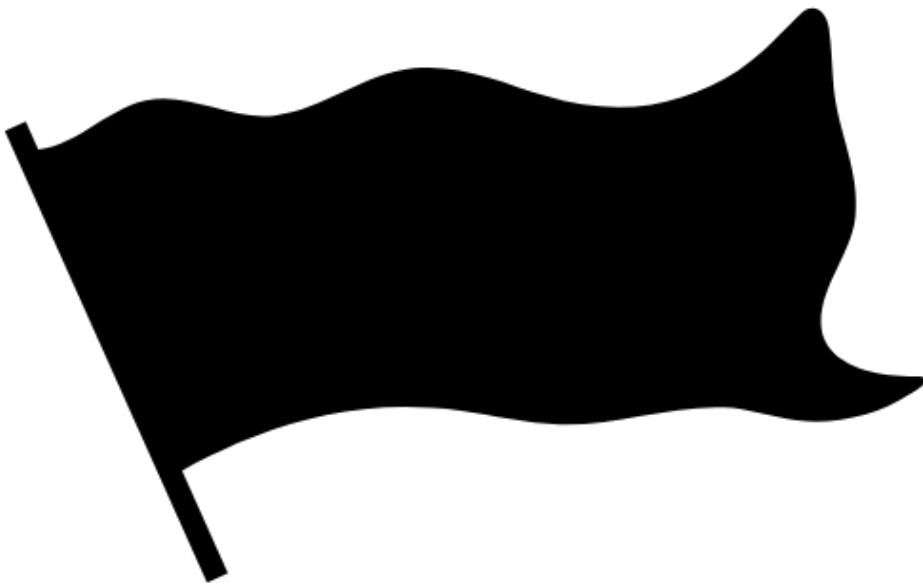


2024 – 2025 Handbook

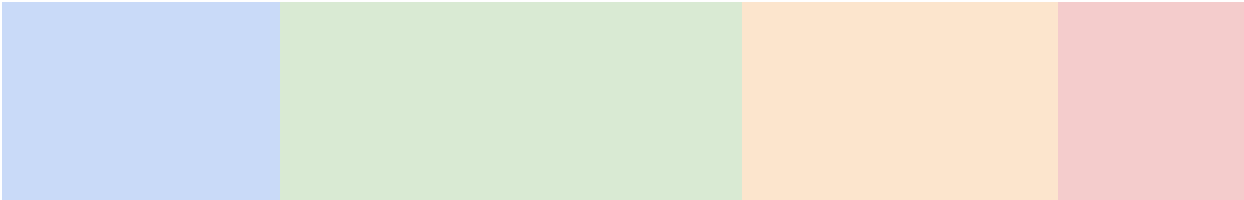
